
Know what happened on the Last Supper. Reflect on how the Mass makes this real for us.

Read and discuss:



Jesus knew that he was going to be betrayed, handed over to his enemies and that he would be put to death on a cross. He freely accepted this suffering and offered his life in love to his Father. This was the most perfect sacrifice which took away the sins committed by everyone, through all ages, right down to you and me and people yet to come.


Read and discuss with a family member:

The Sacrifice of the Mass

By his death on the cross, Jesus shows his great love for his Father and for us. When Jesus died on the cross, he gave everything to God the Fother. This is why we call Jesus' death a sacrifice of love. Jesus' love did not die when he died. His love was so perfect it overcame death and he rose triumphantly.

At Mass, we celebrate that Jesus is alive and always with us. His act of self-giving love is made present for us when the bread and wine is changed into his Body and Blood.

This is a mystery - we don't understand



how it happens, but we believe that it takes place through the power of the Holy Spirit and the action of the priest at Mass.

We understand that if we are to take an active part in the Mass, we must join Jesus, with all his followers, in offering ourselves in love to the Father and to all people.

Read and discuss with a family member:

Our Part in the Mass
