
## Year 3 Optional Homework - Summer 1

We have read Boudicca's inspirational speech that motivated the Iceni tribe to rebel against the Romans? Can you find examples of other women who have made inspirational speeches?




### Computing—Branching databases

Can you design a card to congratulate Father Peter on his anniversary and thank him for his contribution to our Parish?




### PE—Athletics
