Inference	<ol> <li>'We sat there, the three of us, hand in hand, looking down at the delicate creature.' What is Michael thinking?</li> <li>Michael's Mum describes the actions of Skellig. Why didn't Michael tell his parents there and then about him?</li> <li>Did Doctor MacNabola believe that love could help a person get better? Does the William Blake quote help you decide?</li> <li>Michael's relationship with his friends appears to have improved. How do we know this?</li> </ol>

What effect does that have on the reader?</li> <li>What effect does Mum's description of the dream have on the reader?</li> <li>The mood of Michael and his Dad changes during chapter 41. How do we know?</li> <li>Skellig 'sighed with contentment'. What does this tell us?</li> <li>The writer shows that Skellig's attitude towards Michael and Mina has changed over time. How does he convey this?</li> </ol>
Retrieval	<ol> <li>Mum 'knew it was going to be alright'. What happened that gave her such confidence?</li> <li>What made school so brilliant for Michael the next day?</li> </ol>
