What is our vision for your children and for their time in Year 6?

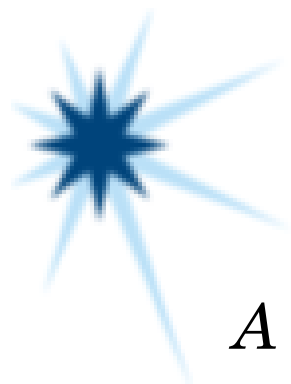
Throughout the year, our mission is for your children to feel safe, valued and more importantly to really love learning.

Due to the demands of the classroom, I will not be able to respond straight away but I will check them on a regular basis and respond as soon as I can.

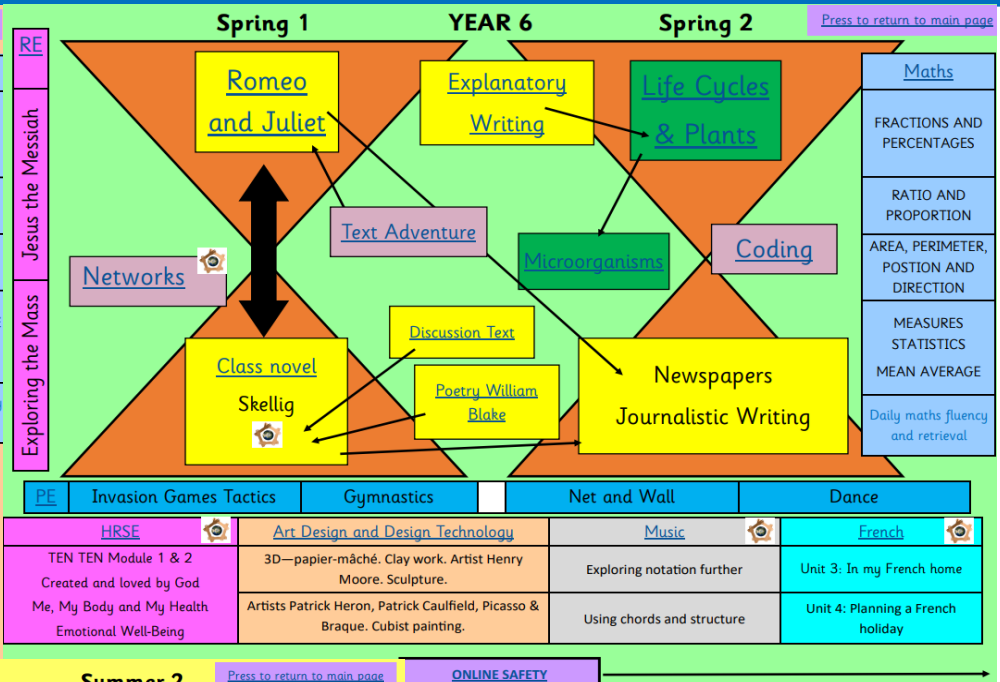
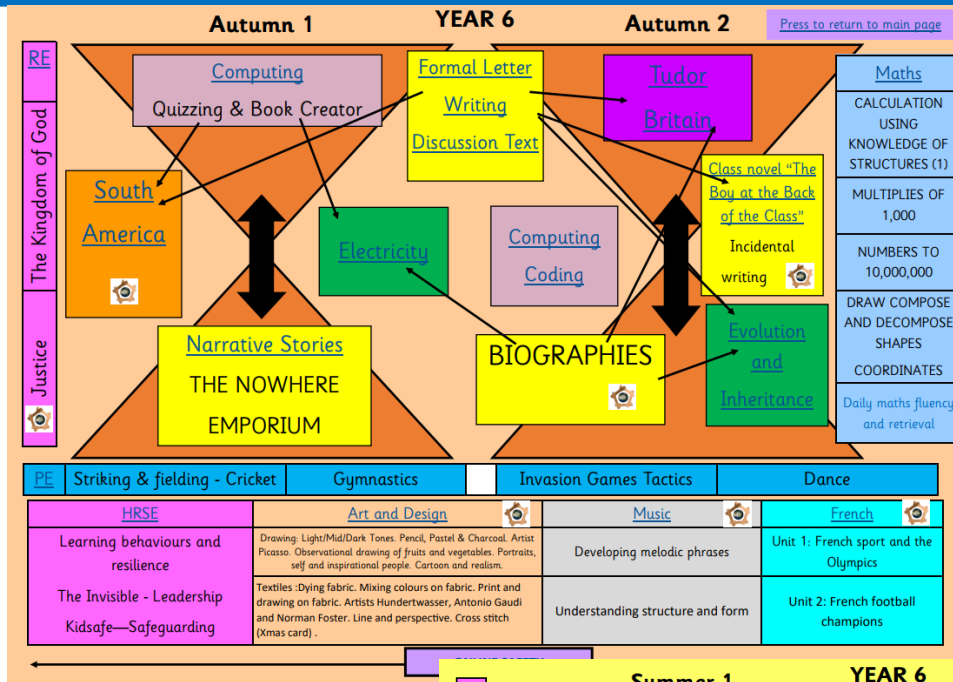

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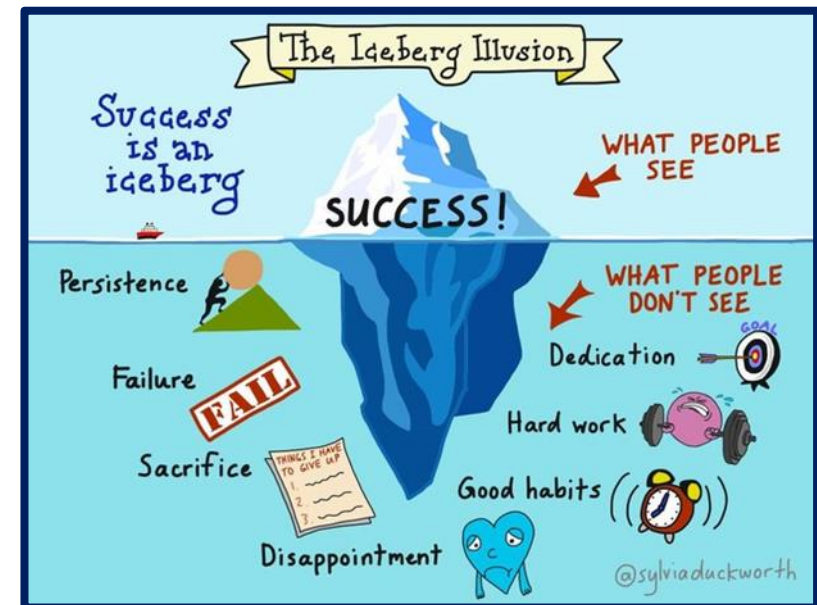
Keeping safe online
