Try to include:

SENSES DESCRIPTION: What the person in the writing can see, hear, feel, smell and sometimes taste.

SIMILES: Where you compare something to something else like it to put a clear picture in reader's head.

Different SENTENCE STARTS: this stops it sounding repetitive and stilted. These are your


